

EDWARD E. PRINCE

1910 DIARY

[The Prince family moves to 30 Blaine St., Santa Cruz in June of this year. Edward's journal picks up at the end of July as the family is painting and wallpapering their new home. Edward begins working at Tanner's Drug Store, located on the ground floor of the St. George Hotel on Pacific Avenue. He rides his new bicycle all over town, attending vaudeville shows, moving picture shows, and swimming at the Plunge. His father is working at the San Vicente Mill. Edward begins taking photographs with his No. 2 Folding Pocket Brownie camera.]

July 1910

- 28 I'd been working in Campbell's store on Soquel Ave but was sick and did not go. We are living at 30 Blaine St Santa Cruz.
- 29 Was not much better. I vomited in the night. Ma went up to the dentists. She started in papering. The baby stood up for about half a minute today.
- 30 We finished papering the kitchen. Pa came down home. He got some shells for the 38-55.
- 31 We all went to the beach and pa, Leslie and I went into the plunge. Pa thought the work was too hard for me at Campbell's store.

August 1910

- 1 I went in swimming in the river. I got a card from George Arano. I sent a card to pa and to Rosie Cousins.
- 2 Ma and I went to the show. Leslie and I went down and fished off the wharf. I caught 3 tomcod.
- 3 Ma got a letter from pa. He didn't get a deer. Ma and I did some papering in the bedroom. Leslie and I went swimming.
- 4 I went fishing and swimming.
- 5 I got a card from Rosie Coussins.
- 6 Ma had the nightmare and jumped off the bed and split her nose open, she swelled her eye up too. Pa came down and brought some venison with him. He killed a spiked buck.
- 7 We staid [sic] home all day after pa went back to work I went fishing and caught 4 fish.
- 8 I went to the show. We got some books out of the library.
- 9 I got a card from Glenn Clifford. Pa came home sick. He had to quit work. The baby is sick.
- 10 The baby is worse. We all have colds. I went to a show and went and staid [sic] over night with Sagners.
- 11 We had to have a docter [sic] for the baby.

- 12 We staid [sic] up all night with the baby. The docter [sic] came again.
- 13 Ethel came down for a visit. She and I went over town and got some things.
- 14 Ethel went back and Leslie went to Boulder Creek with her. The baby is better.
- 15 My birthday. The baby is better today. I am 14 years old. Pa gave me a dollar.
- 16 Pa went back up to San Vicente to work. I took the books back to the library and got two more.
- 17 Ma got a letter from Rosie Coussins and from grandma and Leslie. I got a card from Rosie. Ma got a letter from Grandma Bacon. Grandma brought Leslie back he was sick.
- 18 He is the same. Grandma went back. Mrs. Izant helped docter [sic] Leslie's ear.
- 19 We did some more papering upstairs. I took the two books back and got two more. Ma went over town and got a big musk melon.
- 20 I hoed a lot of weeds in the back yard. Pa came down to stay over Sunday.
- 21 Pa went back up to San Vincente again. I got a funny paper. I didn't go in the plunge today today [sic] because I have a bad cold.
- 22 I got up early and hoed weeds. I took the books back and got two more.
- 23 I got up at 5.20 oclock [sic] and mailed some letters and hoed weeds before breakfast. I got a card from Roy Garretty. Ma got a watermelon.
- 24 I got up early again and hoed weeds. Leslie and I husked some hazel nuts that I picked up at Boulder. I got my Youths Companion. I also got a letter from pa and a card from Rosie Coussins. I bought a \$.50 reel and 60 ft of silk line.
- 25 Leslie and I got a watermelon. We went fishing. I caught 6 and Leslie 2. We got a big load of wood.
- 26 Leslie and I went over to Garfield park at 24 Seaside Ave. and got a gun from L. Hall. I am going to go hunting with it up to San Vicente. Ma painted in the hall. We fixed the screen door. Leslie and I went fishing. I caught 10 and Leslie 2.
- 27 I exchanged my reel for another cause the click on it didn't work. I went up to San Vicente for a hunt with pa.
- 28 Pa and I killed a big deer. It had three points on each horn. I hit it once and pa twice. We sent it down by some other fellows that were hunting.
- 29 I watched pa work in the morning and came home in the afternoon. We sold the deer horns for \$1.00. Ethel came and staid [sic] over night. Leslie started to school.
- 30 Leslie went to school Ethel went back up to Boulder Creek. I took the books back to the library. Leslie and I went to two moving picture shows. I got a watermelon.
- 31 I went down to the wharve [sic] We got a box of apples. Mrs. Cook brought us over some nectrines [sic] and pears.

September 1910

- 1 I took back the two books and got two more. Ma put up 10 quarts of mince meat made out of venison.
- 2 I went fishing and caught 5 trout and 17 bullheads. Pa came down. Ma acts like a fool and don't know what she is talking about. She's getting worse.
- 3 Pa went over town to see about Y. Ito business. Ethel came again. Pa went back up to San Vicente. We watched the fireworks out the window.
- 4 I got an old fashioned dime for my collection. We went down to the beach in the afternoon and listened to the band play.
- 5 Ethel went back. She gave me .50 and Leslie .50 to go to the circus. A preacher came to see ma. He is a nice young fellow. Ma and I went to a moving picture show. Leslie staid [sic] home with the baby.
- 6 I started to work in Reed and Sarrail's plumbing shop. I am getting 58 1/3 cents a day.
- 7 Circus day. I couldn't go cause I had to work. Pa came down in the evening and went back again.
- 8 I worked.
- 9 A holiday Admissions Day. I didn't have to work. I went in the plunge baths. I am learning to ride a bicycle.
- 10 I worked. Payday. I got \$2.50. Pa came down. I gave \$.75 to ma. He got a pair of shoes for me but they were to [sic] small.
- 11 I got some good shoes. Pa went up to San Vicente. We went over to the Hanley Sanitarium to see the Chinaman cook that broke his leg.
- 12 I worked. Ma painted part of the kitchen and pantry. Leslie and I went to a moving picture show.
- 13 I worked. I worked hard today Had to dig a ditch by myself. Leslie went to school. Hot day.
- 14 It rained. I worked. Ma got some books out of the library She got some paints for Leslie.
- 15 It rained. I worked. I went to the Grand theater in the evening.
- 16 I worked. Nothing stirring but the bread line.
- 17 Leslie came over and watched me work. They docked my wages to two and half and I am going to quit.
- 18 I went out to Ven De Leau on the street car and saw the sights and spent some money. Pa came down.
- 19 I worked. Grandpa was sick and pa had to go up to Boulder to see him.
- 20 Pa came back. I worked. Grandpa is better. Ma got sick.
- 21 Pa went back up to San Vicente to work. Ma was sick. I worked.
- 22 I didn't work because I was sick. Ma was sick too. I ve got a curio shop. I have a lot of old hunting licenses, two dimes made in 1867, 14 different kinds of stamps and some fancy seashells I got a china ladder.

- 23 I worked. Ma was sick. My boss was mad because I didn't come yesterday.
- 24 Pay day. I got \$3.00. I went to the Unique theater and the Jewel.
- 25 I am sick today. I've been in bed all day. I can't go in swimming.
- 26 I worked, Leslie went to school. I have \$3.15 saved up for Christmas.
- 27 Rosie Coussins and Charlie Coussins came down for the afternoon.
- 28 I helped make a pair of trays [sic] today.
- 29 I washed all the bathtubs out this morning and also the sinks and basins and toilets. I cut and bent and painted a lot of tin and cut pipe and put thread on it. One of my bosses doesn't like me and the other does so I have a hard time. I went to the moving picture and vaudeville show. I got a letter from pa and one from Ethel.
- 30 I went up town on the car and got some brackets. I cut out some tin flashings and roof plates and painted some more tin today. I went down to 40 S. Branciforte Ave. where grandma and grandpa used to live today.

October 1910

- 1 I got paid. They gave me a check for three dollars. Pa came down. I went to two shows. I went out on the wagon this morning.
- 2 I went over town in the morning and got a paper. I went in the plunge with Leslie in the afternoon. Pa went back. I got .20 worth of candy.
- 3 Buffalo Bills Circus. I couldn't go cause I had to work. My boss went out to collect bills today and he only got 85¢ out of \$700.00. While he was gone, a man came in and paid me \$10.00, so I collected more than he did. He was awful mad.
- 4 I worked hard today. I spilled half my lunch today noon. I got a card from Rosie Coussins. It was so foggy this morning that you couldn't see more than half a block.
- 5 Warm day, today. I went down to a place near the beach and brought up 100 ft of sewer pipe today. I collected \$1.15 for the boss today. My overalls are getting so greasy that I can't hold the baby for fear of getting him dirty too. I smell like a sewer when I get home. I went to a moving picture show and got ten cents worth of candy.
- 6 I worked awful hard today. I mixed cement and carried sewer pipe all afternoon.
- 7 Pa came down. He had me quit at Reed and Sarraills. I went over to Tanner's Drug Store to see about getting another job.
- 8 I started to work at Tanner's Drug Store. I am getting \$25.00 a month. Pa got me a bike with his money but I am going to pay him back.
- 9 I got up at half past five and practised [sic] on my bike. Pa and Leslie went up to San Vicente hunting, they got one rabbit.
- 10 I can ride my bike like anything all ready.
- 11 It rained awful hard today and the breakers were so rough that they dammed up the river.

- 12 It rained hard all night and today. I got wet through. I got a raincoat.
- 13 It cleared up today and the sun came out. I was delivering all over town today.
- 14 Apple day at Watsonville. I got half a day off.
- 15 Pa came down in the evening.
- 16 My Sunday off. I went down to the beach on my bike. I saw George Gregory. Pa went back to work.
- 17 They had me pounding cork at the drug store today and they put castor oil in it to make it soft and I caught on and accidently [sic] broke the mortar [sic].
- 18 Leslie and I went to a moving picture show. L worked hard today.
- 19 Nothing doing today.
- 20 Pa came down this morning. A load of pine wood came today.
- 21 Pa went back up this evening.
- 22 I went to Faits the great hypnotist show tonight. It was fine.
- 23 I had to work today. It was dull too I tell you.
- 24 Miss Cook sent us over some nice big bellflower apples. I took a tumble on my bike today.
- 25 I lost a nut off my bike today. I wrote to pa. I got ma a chamois skin, a tooth brush and some toilet soap and some samples of talcum powder for baby.
- 26 I got some cookies at a grocery store that were rotten today. I coasted down Mission Hill today. My night off tonight but I didn't go to the show. I went to bed at half past six.
- 27 I went clear out to Seabright Avenue twice today. I went all over town too. I wrote to Pa I wish I were fishing now. It is so tiresome. I have to work every other night and every other Sunday.
- 28 I got two old stamps for my collection today. I got a twobit [sic] tip and bought fish bait with it. I got two five cent fly hooks too.
- 29 I took some stuff to the county jail today. It is raining a little this morning. I guess It's trying to spoil my fun, because I can't go fishing if it rains. Pa came home tonight so I guess I won't go.
- 30 It was cloudy this morning, but we went anyhow. Up Scotts Creek beach. and had our lunch. We had a fine time. Pa shot a diver and a killde [sic].
- 31 Halloween night. Leslie and I didn't do a thing. We only soaped windows and soaped the car tracks and took pieces of fence and put them across the street.

November 1910

- 1 I wrote to Pa tonight. I was out to 146 Pennsylvania Ave today.
- 2 I wrote to Pa again. I wrote a little on the type writer today.
- 3 I went out to Twin Lakes on the car this evening. I wrote a letter to pa on the type writer.

- 4 Nothing much doing today. Had to work again tonight.
- 5 Pa came home tonight and wouldn't go to the show with me so I staid [sic] home. They had the Jefferies vrs Johnson fight pictures at the Unique tonight.
- 6 Today is Sunday and I have to work. I got some sen-sen and some chiclets. Pa went back.
- 7 I got a 5 cent tip today. I wrote a letter to Pa on the type-writer.
- 8 Election day. The returns haven't come yet. But I can tell tomorrow. I went clear out to 29 Fern St. tonight after halfpast eight. MY pay day but they didn't pay me. I don't when they will.
- 9 I got paid today. It was twenty-five dollars. I paid the other five on my bike. I gave Ma ten to send to the piano Co. Hiram Johnson was elected (republican) governor of California.
- 10 I got a pair of mud guards for my bike. They cost 2.50. I sent two cards to Charlie and Rosy Coussins.
- 11 X X X X - - - [etc]
- 12 Pa came down tonight. I went to the show.
- 13 I took some pictures with my camera. I took one of the casino and one of the plunge and one of the museum and one of the house. Leslie and I went in the plunge. Pa went back up to San Vicente. I caught 3 fish.
- 14 I got a bell for my bike and a spring for the seat.
- 15 I got a pair of pants and a pair of suspenders. I got a 15 cent tip today. There was a fire in Bias's [sic] coffee store today too.
- 16 I took two more pictures today and gave the roll to Charlie Aydelotte to develop [sic]. A lot of freight came today at the drug store.
- 17 I got my pictures today. They were pretty good. Charlie Aydelotte did them for nothing. Ma got pa's check. He sent it by mail. She gave me a dollar.
- 18 It rained last night and cleared off today. I got a letter from Pa.
- 19 I went to the Opera House tonight on a complimentary ticket. It was bum. Pa came down.
- 20 Sunday. I had to work today. Pa took Leslie back up with him in the morning and sent him down in the evening with a rabbit.
- 21 I washed windows today. I bought a hunting license. I got some twenty two shells too. Charlie Prince was down today. I sent about ten

- 21 [Cont.] thanksgiving cards today. I wrote to pa too.
- 22 Charlie Prince came over and staid [sic] all night. I got a card from Ruth and Alfred today.
- 23 Charlie came for dinner today and went back up again. There was a false fire alarm today. Mr. Kratzenstein came down from Brookdale for good.
- 24 Thanksgiving Day. I had half a day off. I rode Leslie down to the beach on the handle bars of my bike. There were big breakers today. Leslie and [I] plaid [sic] football in the barn. I

had three different kinds of cake for dinner and pumkin [sic] pie and eggs and etc. It started in raining this evening.

- 25 I've got an awful bad cold today. I got a card from Rosie Coussins. The head clerk at the Drug Store laid off for a couple of days.
- 26 I have an awful bad cold this morning. I got a five cent tip. Pa came home tonight.
- 27 Pa and I went up to Swanton this morning. Dick Todd went up with me. I shot a ground squirrel, a diver, two killdees and a rabbit and a bird. We had lots of fun.
- 28 I washed the windows today. Two fellows with fingers cut off came in to the drug store and got them sewed up today.
- 29 I oiled up my bike today. The other boy got off today and went clamming. Palmer got a new boy today.
- 30 I got a five cent tip today. I went to the picture show tonight. I got a new brake put on my wheel. It cost me a dollar.

December 1910

- 1 A lot of freight came today. I got a ten cent tip. I sent a card to pa. We got a stamp machine today at the drug store.
- 2 It rained a little today. I unpacked a lot of bottles today. They brought in a little boy with his collar bone broken and Dr. Morgan fixed it.
- 3 Pa came down because it rained. He and I went to the show. Mr. Mann died.
- 4 I had to work this Sunday. Pa went back. Charlie Prince came down and staid [sic] over night.
- 5 He went up to San Vicente to see pa. Mr. Mann was buried today. Skip to page 132.
- 6 Charlie came back down today. It rained. Ma and I played checkers this evening she beat me. I am taller than Ma now.
- 7 Pa came down and Charlie went up to Boulder and back. Mr. Spangler got killed up at San Vicente. A log rolled of [sic] the car and he went with it and got all smashed up.
- 8 Pa went back today. I got paid today it was \$25.00. I gave ma ten to send to the piano co. That makes twenty dollars I have paid on the piano.
- 9 I bought a lot of Christmas postals today. Leslie and I plaid [sic] foot-ball between 5 and 6 oclock. I had to go back at 6.
- 10 It rained like the dickens today. I had a car ride for nothing clear out to 44 Cayuga St. Ma and I went to the show. It was fine. I hid baby in the clothes basket. Ma couldn't find him.
- 11 My Sunday off. It rained this morning and Pa came down. It cleared off this afternoon and Dick Todd and I went up to Moore's beach and shot at loons and sea brant.
- 12 Mr Spanglers funeral Ma and Pa and Baby went but I had to work. I washed windows today. Frank Julien got fired last night.

- 13 I wrote to Pa tonight. I washed the big mirror today. I washed a lot of bottles today too. I beat ma a game of checkers.
- 14 I got Ma a present [sic] and hid it in the bureau. I have one for Pa too. It cost 3.50.
- 15 I got 10 more post cards for myself and 5 for Leslie. I got two Christmas presents for baby, one for Pa and two for Leslie.
- 16 They gave away five dollars at the Grand Theater I didn't get a chance at it because I had to work.
- 17 Charlie Coussins sent us down some abalonies [sic]. We got a telegram from Charlie Prince asking when Pa would be up.
- 18 I had to work this Sunday. Charlie Aydelotte brought up a new puzzle but we all got it. I wrote to pa.
- 19 Pa's check came today. I was \$62.31. Ma paid the grocer. I got Charlie Coussins a nice deck of cards for Christmas.
- 20 I got about \$5.00 worth of Christmas Presents today. I wrote to grandma. We got a lot of things to send to grandma B. and all of them down there.
- 21 I got two cards today. One from Mot Darling and one from George Arano. I sent a 50¢ deck of cards to Charlie and Rosie Coussins for a Christmas present. I got a ten cent tip today.
- 22 I wrote to Pa again. A package came from grandma and grandpa Bacon. There was \$5.00 for Ma also two aprons two doilys [sic] and a stinkum pack. A pocket mirror and comb for me also a necktie. Same for Leslie and a pair of boots and a bell harness for Baby. Mrs Sinnott and Maime were here for supper.
- 23 I got some more cards.
- 24 Pa got me a new suit of clothes. An old fellow gave Leslie and I each \$5.00.
- 25 Christmas. I got a new suit some mittens a silk scarf. Some suspenders and socks and the things mentioned before.
- 26 I only worked half day. I got a five dollar present from Mrs Tanner. I skated at the rink for the first time in a year and a half.
- 27 I wrote to Pa. Some more presents came from Aunt Emma. There was a necktie for Leslie Pa and I. A collar for ma some Sticks P [pins] for all of us an some slippers for baby.
- 28 It was awfully cold this morning. There hasn't been any rain for 3 weeks.
- 29 I played foot ball with Leslie in the street this noon. I lost a nut of [sic] my bike and had to have a new one. I got me a pair of shoes the other day and forgot to put it down.
- 30 I worked tonight Nothing doing much.
- 31 My night off. I skated at the rink till after 12 o'clock. End of 1910
