Frank McCarrier, Long Owner of Cigar Store, Dies

Francis M. ("Frank") McCarrier, Santa Cruz businessman for more than a quarter of a century, died suddenly of heart disease at his home, 148 Locust street, last evening. He had been ill for several months.

The body was removed to the Wessendorf mortuary. Funeral arrangements were pending today.

Mr. McCarrier, resident of Santa Cruz since 1906, was born in New York 60 years ago. He was proprietor of a cigar store at 140 Pacific avenue until forced to retire from business on account of his health 18 months ago.

One of the boosters for the Greater Santa Cruz Oil company, Mr. McCarrier was accredited with selling \$20,000 worth of stock in the concern. He was a member of the Santa Cruz lodges of Elks and Eagles.
