HIRAM IMUS, Sr.

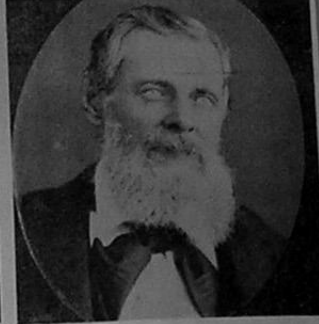

Thomas took charge of the Watsonville store. Here Sept. 1 '53 he married Sarah, a sister of Hiram Scott. He was prominent in Watsonville, joining the militia for the duration of the civil war, owner of considerable property in Sta Cruz, but seems to have had a strong tendency toward keeping out of public affairs. He was the father of two child., one of whom became Mrs. August Hihn of this city. The son, Joseph Fennimore, m a daughter of Nelise Besse. His widow and two child.: Grace (Mrs. Norton) and Fennimore live in Sta Cruz. The third is Milo Cooper of Watsonville.

DOANE, Hadley Bushnell



B in Penn. Aug. 15 '11, to Calif. April 14 '49 by sea; poss. to the mines, but in the winter building a sawmill dam for Isaac Graham and from that time a resident of this county as a Live Oak farmer until his death in '84 (although the date of his signature on the county pioneer roll is given as '86).

BROWN, Alexander

'47, memb. Co. C Mormon bat.; joined the Sta Cruz lodge, Sons of Temperance, '59; private of Co. L 2nd Calif. cav. recruited in Sta Cruz for civil war duty; at Lynne, Utah, '82.
